LIVE THE LITURGY

In response to how the Pharisees and scribes lived their faith, Jesus said, "This people honors me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me." Both good and evil impulses come from our hearts. Which one has the upper hand depends on how well a person has taken on the mind and heart of God. How well we live our faith is determined by the same. As Pope Francis tells us, Jesus is present in all of our brothers and sisters, especially those who endure suffering like his own. Our world is full of tragedy, conflict, and suffering: slave labor, diseases, wars, terrorism, exploitation, famine, human trafficking. We cannot simply pay lip service to the evils of the world ... we must act!

EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP

Justice is a concept under attack in today's world. When I watch the news, I see so many distortions of justice. One person's notion of fairness is sometimes far from another's understanding of justice. Perhaps the issue is that human justice often becomes corrupted by selfishness and greed. Justice for one's self always seems more important than justice for another. As disciples of Jesus Christ, we are called to use what we have been given not only to fight for human justice alone, but also to offer a more benevolent justice that can only come from God. We are called to offer all we have to God for His greater intentions. Our gifts cannot only level the playing field for some but can serve as instruments of grace for those who, in the eyes of the world, do not even deserve it. In God's framework of justice, second chances and overflowing generosity are commonplace. Everyone created in the image of God deserves love regardless of their state in life or the actions they have taken against another. The world will never understand this type of justice. Humans have a hard-enough time figuring out the simple concepts of equity or fair play. For those who do not believe in Jesus, his justice seems even more difficult to comprehend. In fact, it can appear downright crazy.

Judgment tends to have a bad reputation. We often associate it with condemnation, and in the Gospels, we associate it with the Pharisees. Today's Gospel features the Pharisees doing exactly what we expect. "They observed that some of his disciples ate their meals with unclean, that is, unwashed, hands." The Jewish people had strict purification laws that applied to all areas of life. The Pharisees attempt to accuse Jesus of not following the ancestral traditions. Jesus doesn't take offense at their judgments per se. He instead points out the hypocrisy of their words. "You hypocrites ... this people honors me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me." From there, Jesus turns his attention to the concerns of the heart. "The things that come from within are what defile." He lists off a number of sins, including some the Pharisees were likely struggling with, including evil thoughts, envy, and arrogance. When we examine the list, perhaps we're reminded of our own trips to the confessional! As we strive to follow Jesus and live with integrity, we must be aware of our hearts. We must judge our own actions. Are they leading us closer to God or away from Him? Are we growing in love of our neighbor, or are we becoming more closed in on ourselves? As we move into this week, consider the state of our own heart. Perhaps you are overly scrupulous in less important areas. Perhaps there are large areas of overlooked sin that you've excused for too long. Whatever it is, the judgment of God need not cripple us. He offers us a share in His mercy as soon as we turn to Him. This week, allow your heart to be transformed!

A veces, la idea de lo que es justo para una persona es muy diferente a la idea de otra. Quizás el problema es que la justicia humana se corrumpe por el egoísmo y la codicia. A justicia para uno casi siempre se considera más importante que la justicia para el otro. Como discípulos de Jesús, estamos llamados a usar lo que Dios nos ha regalado para no solamente pelear por la justicia, pero también para ofrecer una mejor justicia que solo puede llegar de Dios. Estamos llamados a dar todo lo que tenemos a Dios y para las intenciones de Él. Nuestros regalos no deben aliviar la carga de solamente unas personas, pero sino servir como instrumentos de gracia para los que, en los ojos del mundo, no lo merecen. En el contexto de la justicia de Dios, las segundas oportunidades son abundantes y la generosidad se espera. Todos creados en semejanza de la imagen de Dios merecen el amor, a pesar de su estrado de vida o las acciones que han tomado contra otros. El mundo nunca entenderá este tipo de justicia. A los humanos se nos dificulta entender los conceptos simples de la equidad. Para los que no creen en Jesús, su justicia es aún más difícil de entender. De hecho, puede parecer loca.

La conversión no es fácil, es un proceso de toda la vida y se requiere cierta atención de parte del individuo. Se puede observar interiormente cada acción que se lleve a cabo, y se llega a la conclusión de que sin una relación personal con Dios y con los demás y con una pureza de intención poco se realiza en la vida con relación a este punto. Solamente cuando las acciones salen desde el corazón y se vuelven hacia Dios son puras, son buenas. Es entonces cuando existe la, “Pureza del corazón.” La “Pureza de intención,” Jesús lo explica de la siguiente forma: “*Escúchenme todos y traten de entender. Ninguna cosa que de fuera entra en la persona puede hacerla impura; lo que hace impura a una persona es lo que sale de ella. El que tenga oídos que escuche*”. (Marcos 7:14-16). Primero el corazón y luego todo lo demás, lo que cuenta es cuánto amor ponemos a las cosas que hacemos, la conciencia que nos mueve interiormente para llevar a cabo las decisiones, la intención que nos guía a todo lo que hacemos y hace que la voluntad se ponga en marcha. Jesús, llamó y sigue llamando, a examinar nuestros comportamientos en la vida de todos los días. Si nuestro corazón se enfoca en Dios, todo es más fácil de entender. Un buen discernimiento, viene de saber escuchar a otras personas. Ver, pensar y actuar, ponerse en los zapatos del otro, para no juzgar a la ligera. Las leyes nos ayudan, pero lo esencial es, dónde está el corazón. Sin olvidar que Dios ve lo profundo del mismo. ¿Dónde está tú corazón ahora? ¿Dónde cabe la pureza de tus intenciones?
