LIVE THE LITURGY- INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

St. Theresa of Avila reminds us that, "Christ has no body now on earth but yours; no hands but yours; no feet but yours. Yours are the eyes through which the compassion of Christ must look out on the world. Yours are the feet with which He is to go about doing good. Yours are the hands with which He is to bless His people." We are, in every way shape and form, the Body of Christ. Our bodies are not just one single part but many. We are many, and we are all uniquely different. Yet each in his or her own way contributes significantly to the whole. We are all baptized in one spirit, and there are no distinctions that separate us. We must keep our eyes focused on the greater whole and not get distracted or consumed with particular parts. Everything and everyone must work together for the praise and glory of God.



"He came to Nazareth, where he had grown up." Did you grow up in a small town? Whenever you see stories of tight-knit communities, a common refrain is that everybody knows everybody and that's very difficult to change. If you leave and return, people expect you to be and act a certain way, and it's strange for them if you do not. In today's Gospel, we see that Jesus was already moving "in the power of the Spirit and news of him spread throughout the whole region. He...was praised by all." His ministry has begun! News of his growing popularity must have proceeded him to Nazareth. Upon his arrival, he "went according to his custom into the synagogue on the sabbath day." For the first few moments, he is what they expect - their hometown boy returning to pay his respects. As was common of men at the time, he takes a turn reading a passage of Sacred Scripture. It is a bold passage, one he selects intentionally. "He unrolled the scroll and found the passage where it was written: The Spirit of the Lord is upon me." After reading about holy anointings, liberation for the poor and prisoners, and physical healings, Jesus does the unthinkable. "Today this Scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing." "We are all called to imitate Christ wherever we are. This might mean doing the unexpected! All too often we're content with the daily status quo, and so are the people around us. When we take a stand for Christian values, change our lifestyle to reflect the Gospel, and work for justice in society, we may make others uncomfortable. But Jesus doesn't call us to the same life we lived yesterday or the year before that. He is calling all of us - each and every one of us - to deeper conversion of heart. No matter what

VIVIR LA LITURGIA – INSPIRACIÓN DE LA SEMANA

Santa Teresa de Jesús nos dejó estas palabras: "Cristo no tiene cuerpo, sino el tuyo; no tiene manos o pies en la tierra, sino los tuyos; tuyos son los ojos con los que ve; la compasión en este mundo; tuyos son los pies con los que camina para hacer el bien; tuyas son las manos, con el que bendice todo el mundo." Nosotros somos, en toda manera y forma, el Cuerpo de Cristo. Nuestros cuerpos no son solo una parte, sino muchas. Somos muchos y todos somos únicamente diferentes. Cada individuo, de su propia manera, contribuye algo especial. Todos estamos bautizados en un espíritu, y no hay nada que nos separe. Debemos enfocarnos en la totalidad y no distraernos con los detalles particulares. Todo y todos debemos trabajar juntos para la alabanza y gloria de Dios



La manera como Lucas inicia el Evangelio y orienta al ilustre Teófilo a fin de comprender la solidez de la catequesis que este había recibido. El mensaje transmitido el ordenar los acontecimientos permite también a nosotros hoy, fijar nuestros ojos en Jesús. Así, nos damos cuenta de que, en Nazaret, Jesús proclama su misión: "Enseñaba en las sinagogas de los judíos y todos lo alababan" (Lucas 4:14). Los inicios son importantes porque dan base, son cimientos seguros para iniciar la proclamación de la buena nueva. Lucas tiene un excelente gusto literario. Leer su Evangelio siempre es un deleite ya que muestra claramente la misericordia de Dios por medio de su Hijo Jesús. En su mensaje se destacan cuatro puntos importantes. 1. Jesús anuncia la buena noticia con palabras, acciones y milagros. Es decir, acciones concretas. Siempre acompañado del espíritu de Dios desde su Bautismo. 2. En la sinagoga proclama el conocido pasaje de Isaías 61:1ss. "El Espíritu del Señor esta sobre mí. Él me ha ungido para llevar las buenas noticias a los pobres, para anunciar la libertad a los cautivos y a los ciegos que pronto van a ver, para poner en libertad a los oprimidos y a proclamar el año de gracia del Señor" (Lucas 4; 18-19). El pasaje se puede resumir en lo siguiente: hacer el bien de parte de Dios a toda la humanidad. 3. Jesús anuncia que se ha cumplido la Escritura en él: "Hoy se cumplen estas palabras proféticas y a ustedes les llegan noticias de ello" (Lucas 4:21). 4. Fue en Nazaret donde dio comienzo la actividad pública de Jesús. ¿Crees que Jesús sigue actuando en su Iglesia? ¿Cómo?

WHY DO WE DO THAT? - CATHOLIC LIFE EXPLAINED

Question:

This month, we had the March for Life and the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. What does the Church have to say about having respectful conversations between people who disagree?

Answer:

Christians are not removed from the world and its conflicts. Indeed, Jesus sends us "to the ends of the earth" (Acts 1:8). Due to the complex nature of the human experience, the pressures of cultures that don't share Christian values, and the difficulty of living the Gospel, even people of good will have conflicts! The Church has disagreements within herself. This has been the case from the beginning. In the letters of Paul, we see him writing to churches who disagree on how to best live the Gospel in everyday life. And different teachers went to cities after Paul and sometimes preached conflicting messages on who Jesus was.
 When we encounter people who disagree with us - on topics large and small - we must remember basic Christian values. Respect and compassion are critically important. We need to be good listeners to grasp another person's perspective. This dialogue doesn't mean we compromise our values or deny the truth. We may still disagree, but our conversation can be a lot more civil if we try to understand each other!

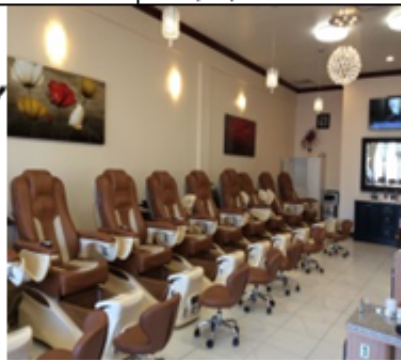

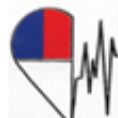
